The board shall adopt a procedure to assess 20 21 a license holder's participation and performance in continuing competence activities [education programs]. 22 (c) The board may [shall] identify the key factors for the 23 competent performance by a license holder of the license holder's 24

(d) In developing a process under Subsection (a) for the
[evaluation and] approval of continuing <u>competence activities</u>
[education courses], the board <u>may</u> [shall] authorize <u>appropriate</u>
[license holder peer] organizations to [evaluate and] approve <u>the</u>
<u>activities</u> [courses in accordance with the established process].

7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
