4	SECTION 1. Section 201.103, Transportation Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(a) The <u>director</u> [commission], under the direction and the
7	approval of the commission shall [plan and make policies for the
8	location, construction, and maintenance of a comprehensive system
9	of state highways and public roads] submit to the legislature for
10	approval, by February 1st of each odd year, its recommendations for
11	a two year comprehensive strategic highway system plan.
12	(b) The plan required by Subsection (a) shall include:
13	(1) the location, construction, and maintenance of
14	state highways and public; and
15	(2) recommendations submitted by metropolitan
16	planning organization as defined by Section 472.031.
17	[(b)] (c) The commission shall designate as part of the
18	state highway system a highway that it determines is necessary for
19	the proper development and operation of the system. The commission
20	may remove a segment of the state highway system that it determines
21	is not needed for the system. In planning and making policies, the
22	commission shall consider, for incorporation into the state highway
23	system, turnpikes that other governmental or private entities are
24	authorized to construct.

[(c)] (d) The commission biennially shall submit a report of
 its work to the governor and the legislature. [The report must
 include the recommendations of the commission and of the director.

4 [(d) The director, under the direction and with the approval
5 of the commission, shall prepare a comprehensive plan providing a
6 system of state highways.]

7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
