2 conveyed [may be delivered by mailing the information] by certified
3 mail, return receipt requested.

4 SECTION 2. Sections 117.012(i) and (j), Natural Resources 5 Code, are amended to read as follows:

6 (i) If the operator or operator's representative cannot 7 arrange a meeting in person after complying with Subsection (h), 8 the operator or the operator's representative shall [make an 9 effort, by one of the following methods, to] conduct community 10 liaison activities by <u>one of the following methods</u> [means of a 11 telephone conference call with the officials]:

12 (1) <u>holding</u> [mailing a written request for] a 13 telephone conference with [to] the appropriate officials [by 14 certified mail, return receipt requested]; or

15 (2) <u>delivering</u> [sending a request for a telephone 16 conference to the appropriate officials by facsimile transmission; 17 or

18 [(3) making one or more telephone calls or e-mail 19 message transmissions to the appropriate officials to request a 20 telephone conference.

[(j) If the operator or the operator's representative has made the efforts required by Subsections (h) and (i) but has not successfully arranged a meeting in person or a telephone conference,] the community liaison information required to be conveyed [may be delivered by mailing the information] by certified mail, return receipt requested.
