- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 42.2525 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 42.2525. ADJUSTMENT FOR DISTRICTS IN CERTAIN COUNTIES.
- 9 <u>(a)</u> In this section, "weighted average daily attendance" has the
- 10 meaning assigned by Section 42.302.
- (b) For each county with a population of at least three
- 12 <u>million</u>, the commissioner shall:
- 13 (1) identify the district located entirely or
- 14 partially in the county that is entitled under this chapter to the
- 15 greatest amount of state and local revenue per student in weighted
- 16 average daily attendance of any district located entirely or
- 17 partially in the county; and
- 18 (2) for each other district located entirely or
- 19 partially in the county that imposes a maintenance and operations
- 20 tax at a rate at least equal to the rate imposed by the district
- 21 <u>identified under Subdivision (1)</u>, adjust the amount to which the
- 22 other district is entitled under this chapter as necessary to
- 23 provide that district with an amount of state and local revenue per
- 24 student in weighted average daily attendance equal to the amount to

- 1 which the district identified under Subdivision (1) is entitled.
- 2 <u>(c) The amount to which a district is entitled under this</u>
- 3 section is in addition to the amount to which the district is
- 4 <u>entitled under Section 42.2516.</u>
- 5 (d) A determination by the commissioner under this section
- 6 <u>is final and may not be appealed.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
