

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the naming of certain Texas Department of
3 Transportation property in Val Verde County.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Transportation Code, is amended by
6 adding Subchapter Y to read as follows:

7 SUBCHAPTER Y. DEPARTMENT BUILDING NAMES

8 Sec. 201.2001. HONORABLE HILARY B. DORAN TRANSPORTATION
9 BUILDING. The building in which, on June 1, 2009, is located the
10 office of the area engineer for Val Verde County is designated as
11 the Honorable Hilary B. Doran Transportation Building.

12 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
13 is amended by adding Section 225.072 to read as follows:

14 Sec. 225.072. LOOP 79 IN VAL VERDE COUNTY. (a) In
15 recognition of the cooperation between the department and Val Verde
16 County, the designation of Loop 79 in Val Verde County shall be made
17 by the Commissioners Court of Val Verde County.

18 (b) The department shall design and construct markers to be
19 placed along Loop 79 in Val Verde County indicating the highway
20 number, the designation of the loop, and any other appropriate
21 information.

22 (c) The department shall erect a marker at each end of the
23 loop and at intermediate sites along the loop that the department
24 determines are appropriate.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
5 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
