The following sections of the Health and Safety 20 21 Code are repealed: 22 (1) Section 242.005; and (2) Sections 247.050(b) and (c). 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
