10	(1) "Central business district" has the meaning
11	assigned by Section 109.36.
12	(2) "Plasma center" means a publicly or privately
13	operated facility at which individuals may donate blood plasma.
14	(3) "Open container" has the meaning assigned by
15	Section 109.35.
16	(b) The commissioners court of a county may enact
17	regulations applicable in areas in the county outside an
18	incorporated city or town, and the governing board of an
19	incorporated city or town may enact regulations applicable in the
20	city or town, prohibiting the possession of an open container or the
21	consumption of an alcoholic beverage on a public street, public

alley, or public sidewalk within 1,000 feet of the property line of

a plasma center that is not located in a central business district.
