(a) The board shall collect data and maintain a database 10 relating to specialized technology research projects that are 11 12 developed or conducted at institutions of higher education, research facilities of institutions of higher education, or other 13 14 facilities operated by a state agency in order to facilitate coordination among the institutions and facilities on the projects. 15 16 (b) The database must include: 17 (1) a list of any projects involving one or more of the following areas: 18 (A) energy research, including methods of 19 creation, storage, distribution, and conservation of energy; 20 21 (B) biomedical science research; 22 (C) nanotechnology research, including 23 nanomedicine; and 24 (D) other specialized technology research;

1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
