- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1305.002, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subdivision (1-b) to read as follows:
- 7 (1-b) "Apprenticeship training program" means a
- 8 program recognized by the Texas Workforce Commission or the Texas
- 9 Higher Education Coordinating Board that combines technical
- 10 classroom instruction and structured on-the-job training for
- 11 electrical apprentices.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 1305.168, Occupations Code, is amended
- 13 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 14 follows:
- 15 (b) Continuing education courses that satisfy the
- 16 requirements of <u>Subsection (a)</u> [this section] must address <u>safety</u>,
- 17 <u>electrical theory</u>, the National Electrical Code, as adopted under
- 18 Section 1305.101, and state laws and rules that regulate the
- 19 conduct of license holders under this chapter.
- 20 (b-1) To renew an electrical apprentice license, a license
- 21 holder who is not enrolled in an apprenticeship training program
- 22 <u>must complete four hours of continuing education annually.</u>
- 23 Continuing education courses that satisfy the requirements of this
- 24 subsection must address safety, the National Electrical Code, as

- 1 adopted under Section 1305.101, and state laws and rules that
- 2 regulate the conduct of license holders under this chapter.
- 3 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to the
- 4 renewal of an electrical apprentice license that expires on or
- 5 after the effective date of this Act. A license that expires before
- 6 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 7 the date the license was issued, and the former law is continued in
- 8 effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
