- 8 license under this section to a person licensed to practice nursing
- 9 in Mexico if the person:
- 10 (1) applies on a form prescribed by the board and pays

- 12 (2) has received a score of at least 475 on a Test of
- 13 English as a Foreign Language examination;
- 14 (3) has received a score acceptable to the board on an
- 15 English language version of the appropriate National Council
- 16 Licensure Examination;
- 17 (4) is eligible for employment in the United States;
- 18 <u>and</u>

- 19 <u>(5) will practice nursing in a county that borders</u>
- 20 <u>Mexico.</u>
- 21 (b) A license issued under this section is valid for one
- 22 year and may be renewed by the board. To renew the license, the
- 23 applicant must have received a score of at least 550 on a Test of
- 24 English as a Foreign Language examination.

- 1 (c) A person who holds a license issued under this section
- 2 may practice nursing only as an employee of a hospital located in a
- 3 county that borders Mexico.
