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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 20, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 7 Subchapter F to read as follows:
- 8 SUBCHAPTER F. HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMISSION AND HEALTH AND
- 9 HUMAN SERVICES AGENCIES
- Sec. 20.151. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
- 11 (1) "Commission" means the Health and Human Services
- 12 <u>Commission</u>.
- 13 (2) "Executive commissioner" means the executive
- 14 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission.
- 15 (3) "Health and human services agencies" has the
- 16 meaning assigned by Section 531.001, Government Code.
- Sec. 20.152. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER PROVISIONS. The other
- 18 provisions of this chapter apply to the commission and health and
- 19 <u>human services agencies except provisions that conflict with this</u>
- 20 <u>subchapter</u>.
- Sec. 20.153. FORMS AND PROCEDURES. (a) The executive
- 22 commissioner shall prescribe and require use by the commission and
- 23 health and human services agencies of forms and procedures that
- 24 combine each application form for a benefits program administered

- 1 by the commission or a health and human services agency with an
- 2 officially prescribed voter registration application form.
- 3 (b) The executive commissioner shall prescribe and require
- 4 use by the commission and health and human services agencies of a
- 5 change of address form and procedure that combines commission or
- 6 health and human services agency functions and voter registration
- 7 functions. The form must allow a recipient of benefits to indicate
- 8 whether the change of address is also to be used for voter
- 9 registration purposes.
- 10 (c) The design, content, and physical characteristics of
- 11 the forms required by this section must be approved by the secretary
- 12 of state.
- 13 <u>(d) Forms required under this section must include the</u>
- 14 following statement in a prominent location: "If you are not a
- 15 <u>citizen of the United States, it is illegal for you to register to</u>
- 16 <u>vote."</u>
- 17 Sec. 20.154. REGISTRATION PROCEDURES. (a) If a person
- 18 completes a voter registration application provided under Section
- 19 20.153, the commission or health and human services agency, as
- 20 appropriate, shall:
- 21 (1) input the information provided on the application
- 22 <u>into the commission's or agency's electronic data system; and</u>
- 23 (2) inform the applicant that the applicant's
- 24 electronic signature provided to the commission or agency will be
- 25 used for submitting the applicant's voter registration

- 27 (b) Not later than the fifth day after the date an applicant

- 6 (c) The secretary of state shall prescribe additional
- 7 procedures as necessary to implement this section.
- 8 Sec. 20.155. DECLINATION FORM NOT REQUIRED. The commission
- 9 and the health and human services agencies are not required to
- 10 comply with the procedures prescribed by this chapter relating to
- 11 the form for a declination of voter registration.
- 12 SECTION 2. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 13 Human Services Commission shall prescribe the forms and procedures
- 14 necessary to implement Subchapter F, Chapter 20, Election Code, as
- 15 added by this Act, not later than January 1, 2011.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
