4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 38.0151 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 38.0151. RULES CONCERNING ADMINISTRATION AND
8	MAINTENANCE OF ANAPHYLAXIS MEDICINE ON CAMPUS. (a) The
9	commissioner by rule shall:
10	(1) adopt standardized procedures for school
11	personnel to follow if a person on campus experiences an
12	anaphylactic reaction;
13	(2) require each school district to maintain a
14	physician's standing order under which a school nurse is authorized
15	to administer anaphylaxis medicine to a person on campus
16	experiencing an anaphylactic reaction; and
17	(3) require a district to maintain at each campus at
18	which a school nurse serves on a part-time or full-time basis a
19	supply of anaphylaxis medicine for administration to a person on
20	campus experiencing an anaphylactic reaction for the first time.
21	(b) In adopting rules under Subsection (a), the
22	commissioner shall consult with one or more physicians experienced
23	in treating persons experiencing an anaphylactic reaction.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
