- 7 Sec. 38.0151. RULES CONCERNING ADMINISTRATION AND
- 8 MAINTENANCE OF ANAPHYLAXIS MEDICINE ON CAMPUS. (a) The
- 9 commissioner by rule shall:
- 10 (1) adopt standardized procedures for school
- 11 personnel to follow if a person on campus experiences an
- 12 <u>anaphylactic reaction;</u>
- 13 (2) require each school district to maintain a
- 14 physician's standing order under which a school nurse is authorized
- 15 to administer anaphylaxis medicine to a person on campus
- 16 experiencing an anaphylactic reaction; and
- 17 (3) require a district to maintain at each campus at
- 18 which a school nurse serves on a part-time or full-time basis a
- 19 supply of anaphylaxis medicine for administration to a person on
- 20 campus experiencing an anaphylactic reaction for the first time.
- 21 (b) In adopting rules under Subsection (a), the
- 22 commissioner shall consult with one or more physicians experienced
- 23 in treating persons experiencing an anaphylactic reaction.

- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
