- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 38.0151 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 38.0151. MAINTAINING ANAPHYLAXIS MEDICINE ON CAMPUS.
- 8 (a) A school district shall maintain at each campus at which a
- 9 school nurse serves on a part-time or full-time basis a supply of
- 10 anaphylaxis medicine that may be administered to persons on campus
- 11 <u>experiencing an anaphylactic reaction.</u> For anaphylaxis medicine
- 12 to satisfy this subsection, the medicine may not have an expiration
- 13 date that has passed.
- 14 (b) The commissioner by rule shall establish the amount of
- 15 anaphylaxis medicine that must be maintained at a campus for
- 16 purposes of Subsection (a). In adopting a rule under this
- 17 subsection, the commissioner shall consult with one or more
- 18 physicians experienced in treating persons experiencing an
- 19 anaphylactic reaction.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
