4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 15.001 and 15.002, Election Code, are
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 15.001. REQUIRED CONTENTS. (a) Each voter
8	registration certificate issued must <u>be identical in form as a</u>
9	driver's license, including identical materials, and contain:
10	(1) the voter's name in the form indicated by the
11	voter, subject to applicable requirements prescribed by Section
12	13.002 and by rule of the secretary of state;
13	(2) the voter's residence address or, if the residence
14	has no address, the address at which the voter receives mail and a
15	concise description of the location of the voter's residence;
16	(3) the month, day, and year of the voter's birth;
17	(4) the number of the county election precinct in
18	which the voter resides;
19	(5) the voter's effective date of registration if an
20	initial certificate;
21	(6) the voter's registration number;
22	(7) an indication of the period for which the
23	certificate is issued;
24	(8) a statement explaining the circumstances under

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1 which the voter will receive a new certificate;

2 (9) a space for stamping the voter's political party3 affiliation;

4 (10) a statement that voting with the certificate by a
5 person other than the person in whose name the certificate is issued
6 is a felony;

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(11) a space for the voter's signature;

8 (12) a statement that the voter must sign the 9 certificate personally, if able to sign, immediately on receipt;

10 (13) a space for the voter to correct the information11 on the certificate followed by a signature line;

12 (14) the statement: "If any information on this 13 certificate changes or is incorrect, correct the information in the 14 space provided, sign below, and return this certificate to the 15 voter registrar.";

16 (15) the registrar's mailing address and telephone 17 number; [and]

(16) the jurisdictional or distinguishing number for the following territorial units in which the voter resides, as determined by the voter registrar:

2	(18) a representation of the Texas flag; and
3	(18) on the reverse, a strip for
4	electronically-readable information.
5	(b) A certificate may not contain:
6	(1) the voter's telephone number;
7	(2) the voter's social security number; or
8	(3) except as provided by Section 15.002, any other
9	information not specified by Subsection (a).
10	(c) The certificate issued under this section is the only
11	form of identification a voter must present to an election official
12	in order to exercise the person's fundamental right to vote. If the
13	provisions of another law conflict with the provisions of this
14	section, this section controls to the extent of the conflict.
15	Sec. 15.002. OPTIONAL CONTENTS. (a) A voter registration
16	certificate may <u>be accompanied by a separate sheet</u> contain an
17	explanation of the voter's rights or duties under this code,
18	including:
19	(1) the procedure by which the voter will receive a
20	<pre>renewal certificate;</pre>
21	(2) the necessity of notifying the registrar if the
22	voter changes residence;
23	(3) the necessity of applying for a new registration
24	if the voter changes residence to another county;
25	(4) the period during which the voter may vote a
26	limited ballot after changing residence to another county;
27	(5) the procedure for voting without a certificate;

2 (6) the procedure for obtaining a replacement for a3 lost or destroyed certificate.

4 [(b) An explanation authorized by Subsection (a) may appear
5 on a separate sheet accompanying the certificate when it is
6 delivered.]

7 (c) In addition to the territorial units required to be 8 listed on a voter registration certificate under Section 9 15.001(a)(16), a certificate may contain up to seven jurisdictional 10 or distinguishing numbers for any other territorial units in which 11 the voter resides.

12 [(d) A voter registration certificate may contain the 13 voter's sex.]

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
