## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the composition of the Texas Medical Board.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 152.002(a), Occupations Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(a) The board consists of $31$ [ $19$ ] members appointed by the
7	governor with the advice and consent of the senate as follows:
8	(1) twelve members who are learned and eminent
9	physicians licensed in this state for at least three years before
10	the appointment, nine of whom must be graduates of a reputable
11	medical school or college with a degree of doctor of medicine (M.D.)
12	and three of whom must be graduates of a reputable medical school or
13	college with a degree of doctor of osteopathic medicine (D.O.);
14	(2) twelve members who are learned and eminent
15	non-physician health care providers in this state for at least
16	three years before the appointment, two of whom shall be licensed
17	therapeutic optometrists, two of whom shall be licensed dentists,
18	two of whom shall be licensed podiatrists, two of whom shall be
19	licensed chiropractors, two of whom shall be licensed nurses and
20	two of whom shall be licensed acupuncturists; and
21	(3) [ $(2)$ ] seven members who represent the public.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
