## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the criminal consequences of operating a motorcycle on

- 3 which a person younger than five is a passenger.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.416, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), an operator may
- 8 not carry another person on a motorcycle unless the other person is
- 9 at least five years of age. An offense under this subsection is a
- 10 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 or more than
- 11 \$200. It is a defense to prosecution under this subsection that the
- 12 operator was operating the motorcycle in an emergency or for a law
- 13 <u>enforcement purpose.</u>
- 14 (e) Subsection (d) does not prohibit an operator from
- 15 carrying on a motorcycle a person younger than five years of age who
- 16 <u>is seated in a sidecar attached to the motorcycle.</u>
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 20 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 21 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 22 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 23 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 24 committed before that date.
