15	spring, detent, or other mechanism designed to create a bias toward
16	closure and that requires exertion applied to the blade by hand,
17	wrist, or arm to overcome resistance and open the knife.
18	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
19	to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
20	An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
21	covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the

former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of

this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of

this Act if any element of the offense was occurred before that
