- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 541.152, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 541.152. DAMAGES, ATTORNEY'S FEES, AND OTHER RELIEF.
- 7 (a) A plaintiff who prevails in an action under this subchapter may
- 8 obtain:
- 9 (1) the amount of damages for mental anguish and other
- 10 actual damages, plus court costs and reasonable and necessary
- 11 attorney's fees;
- 12 (2) an order enjoining the act or failure to act
- 13 complained of; or
- 14 (3) any other relief the court determines is proper.
- 15 (b) On a finding by the trier of fact that the defendant
- 16 knowingly committed the act complained of, the trier of fact may
- 17 award an amount not to exceed three times the amount of actual
- 18 damages. A finding that the defendant acted knowingly shall not be
- 19 a prerequisite to the recovery of any actual damages.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an action commenced on
- 21 or after the effective date of this Act. An action that is
- 22 commenced before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 23 law applicable to the action immediately before the effective date
- 24 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
