2	relating to "Welcome to Texas" signs on highways entering Texas and
3	to the placement of Texas flags at international ports-of-entry.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 201.617, Transportation Code, as added
6	by Acts, 2005, 79th Legislature, and amended by Acts, 2007, 80th
7	Legislature is hereby repealed.
8	SECTION 2. Chapter 201, Transportation Code, is amended by
9	adding Section 201.979 to read as follows:
10	Sec. 201.979. "WELCOME TO TEXAS" SIGNS. (a) The
11	department shall erect a "Welcome to Texas" sign to designate the
12	state boundary on an interstate, United States, or state highway
13	entering the state.
14	(b) A "Welcome to Texas" sign erected by the department must
15	include the following elements:
16	(1) a depiction of the state flag; and
17	(2) the phrase "Drive Friendly - The Texas Way."
18	(c) A "Welcome to Texas" sign may also include the phrase
19	"Welcome to Texas - Proud Home of Presidents Lyndon B. Johnson,
20	George H.W. Bush, and George W. Bush."
21	(d) Notwithstanding subsection (c) above, if the president
22	of the United States is a resident of Texas, a "Welcome to Texas"
23	sign erected by the department shall include the phrase "Welcome to

Texas - Proud Home of President [insert name of the president of the

- 2 SECTION 3. Chapter 201, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 3 adding Section 201.980 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 201.980. TEXAS FLAGS AT INTERNATIONAL PORTS-OF-ENTRY.
- 5 (a) The department shall erect and maintain a Texas flag to
- 6 designate the state boundary at an appropriate location at or near
- 7 <u>each interstate</u>, United States, or state highway originating at an
- 8 official port-of-entry along an international border.
- 9 (b) A Texas flag flown under this section shall be visible
- 10 from the international port-of-entry and must be equal in size or
- 11 larger than the flag of any foreign nation flown at the
- 12 port-of-entry operating on the other side of the international
- 13 border.
- 14 (c) The department may contract with any governmental or
- 15 private entity for the care and maintenance of any Texas flag flown
- 16 under this section.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2010.
