- 5 SECTION 1. Section 15.301, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 There is created a fund in the state treasury to be known as
- 8 the storage acquisition fund which is to be funded by direct
- 9 appropriation, by interest earned on money credited to the storage
- 10 <u>acquisition fund</u>, and by transfers from the <u>water assistance</u> fund
- 11 at the discretion of the board.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 15.302, Water Code, is amended to add
- 13 Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 14 (c) The board may make transfers to the state participation
- 15 account under Subchapter E, Chapter 16, to pay the principal of or
- 16 interest on or both the principal of and interest on bonds or other
- obligations issued or to be issued by a political subdivision or by
- 18 the board in support of the optimum regional development of a state
- 19 participation project.
- SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 17.957, Water Code, is
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- 22 (b) The state participation account is composed of:
- 23 (1) money and assets attributable to water financial
- 24 assistance bonds designated by the board as issued for projects

- 1 described in Section 16.131;
- 2 (2) money from the sale, transfer, or lease of a
- 3 project described in Subdivision (1) that was acquired,
- 4 constructed, reconstructed, developed, or enlarged with money from
- 5 the state participation account;
- 6 (3) payments received under a bond enhancement
- 7 agreement with respect to water financial assistance bonds
- 8 designated by the board as issued for projects described in Section
- 9 16.131;
- 10 (4) investment income earned on money on deposit in
- 11 the state participation account;
- 12 (5) money transferred from the storage acquisition
- 13 <u>fund under Subchapter E, Chapter 15; and</u>
- 14 (6) any other funds, regardless of their source, that
- 15 the board directs be deposited to the credit of the state
- 16 participation account.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
