A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the monumentation of residential subdivisions in a 3 municipality.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 212, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 212.0041 as follows:
- 7 Sec. 212.0041. MONUMENTATION OF RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISIONS.
- 8 (a) For any residential subdivision that requires construction of
- 9 infrastructure improvements, the registered professional land
- 10 surveyor shall set or have set under his/her direct supervision the
- 11 required subdivision corners as follows:
- 12 (1) All subdivision corners as noted on a plat
- 13 required by Section 212.004 prior to the recordation of the
- 14 subdivision plat; or

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- 15 (2) The exterior/perimeter subdivision boundary
- 16 corners as set prior to the commencement of infrastructure
- 17 improvements, and within the earlier of one calendar year of
- 18 recordation of the subdivision plat or six months of final
- 19 acceptance of the infrastructure improvements by the approving
- 20 authority, all of the required interior lot corners and all of the
- 21 lost or destroyed exterior/perimeter subdivision boundary corners
- 22 and right-of-way corners.
- 23 (b) If all required subdivision corners have not been set in
- 24 accordance with subsection (a)(1), the registered professional

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- 1 land surveyor shall indicate by plat notation the monuments that
- 2 will be set subsequent to recordation of the plat, and will include
- 3 the following notation in the plat certification: "Monuments as
- 4 noted to be set in accordance with Sec. 212.0041, Texas Local
- 5 Government Code."
- 6 (c) A plat with the notation under Subsection (b) shall have
- 7 recorded with the county clerk of the county in which the land is
- 8 located, an affidavit stating that the required subdivision corners
- 9 as noted on the plat have been set.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
