- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.025(b-1), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) The State Board of Education by rule shall require
- 8 that:
- 9 (1) except as provided by Subsection (b-2), the
- 10 curriculum requirements for the recommended and advanced high
- 11 school programs under Subsection (a) include a requirement that
- 12 students successfully complete:
- 13 <u>(A)</u> four courses in each subject of the
- 14 foundation curriculum under Section 28.002(a)(1); or
- 15 (B) a career and technology curriculum that
- 16 provides a program of rigorous, standards-based coursework
- 17 designed to prepare students to attend a postsecondary educational
- 18 <u>institution</u> that primarily offers associate's degrees or
- 19 certificates or other credentials other than baccalaureate or
- 20 <u>advanced degrees;</u> and
- 21 (2) one or more courses offered in the required
- 22 curriculum for the recommended and advanced high school programs
- 23 include a research writing component.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with students who

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- 1 enter the ninth grade in the 2010-2011 school year.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
