5	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 3, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 114 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 114. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS APPLICABLE TO MULTIPLE HEALTH
8	OCCUPATION REGULATORY AGENCIES
9	Sec. 114.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Health care practitioner" means an individual
11	issued a license, certificate, registration, title, permit, or
12	other authorization to engage in a health care profession.
13	(2) "Health occupation regulatory agency" means a
14	department, commission, board, office, authority, or other agency
15	of the state that regulates a health care practitioner under this
16	title.
17	Sec. 114.002. ANNUAL REPORT TO LEGISLATURE. (a) Not later
18	than February 1 of each year, each health occupation regulatory
19	agency shall file a report with the chairs of the house and senate
20	committees with primary oversight over the agency that includes the
21	following:

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regulation by the agency in the previous year;

(1) the number of persons regulated by the agency;

(2) the number of persons who became subject to

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- 1 (3) the number of persons regulated by the agency by
- 2 county;
- 3 (4) a description of any complaints reported to the
- 4 agency or a description of the complaint categories used by the
- 5 agency and the number of complaints in each category;
- 6 (5) the number of complaints investigated by the
- 7 agency and a description of the final resolution of the complaints;
- 8 (6) the amount of fees collected by the agency each
- 9 <u>year</u>;
- 10 (7) the expenses of the agency; and
- 11 (8) any unfunded needs of the agency.
- 12 (b) The Health Professions Council shall adopt a standard
- 13 format that must be used by health occupation regulatory agencies
- 14 to report the information required under Subsection (a).
- 15 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2010, the Health
- 16 Professions Council shall adopt the standard reporting format
- 17 required under Subsection (b), Section 114.002, Occupations Code,
- 18 as added by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
