## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to reporting by the Department of State Health Services
3	regarding services provided at school-based health centers.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 38.063(g), Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(g) The commissioner of public health shall require client
8	surveys to be conducted in school-based health centers funded
9	through grants awarded under this section[, and the results of
10	those surveys must be included in the annual report required under
11	Section 38.064].
12	SECTION 2. Section 38.064, Education Code, is amended to
13	read as follows:
14	Sec. 38.064. REPORT TO LEGISLATURE. (a) Based on
15	statistics obtained from every school-based health center in this
16	state that receives funding through the Department of State Health
17	Services, the Department of State Health Services [commissioner of
18	<pre>public health] shall issue a biennial [an annual] report to the</pre>
19	legislature about the [relative efficacy of] services delivered by
20	the [school-based health] centers during the preceding two years
21	[and any increased academic success of students at campuses served
22	by those centers, with special emphasis on any:

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[(1) increased attendance;

[(2) decreased drop-out rates;

- 1 [(3) improved student health; and
- 2 [(4) improved performance on student assessment
- 3 instruments administered under Subchapter B, Chapter 39].
- 4 (b) The report must address the extent to which the
- 5 services provided by the centers are considered by the Department
- 6 of State Health Services to have resulted in:
- 7 (1) improved school attendance by students with
- 8 chronic illnesses;
- 9 (2) increased student immunization rates; and
- 10 (3) increased student participation in preventive
- 11 health measures, including routine physical examinations and
- 12 checkups conducted in accordance with the Texas Health Steps
- 13 program [In obtaining statistics for preparation of the report
- 14 required by this section, the commissioner of public health shall
- 15 ensure that data is collected for each county and aggregated
- 16 appropriately according to geographical region].
- 17 (c) The Department of State Health Services may modify any
- 18 requirement imposed by this section if necessary to comply with
- 19 federal law regarding confidentiality of medical information.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
