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- 2 relating to the calculation of the rollback tax rate of a school
- 3 district.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 26.08, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (p) to read as follows:
- 7 (p) Notwithstanding Subsections (n) and (o), a school
- 8 district is not required to obtain the approval at an election under
- 9 this section of the district's adopted tax rate if the rate does not
- 10 exceed the sum of:
- 11 (1) the maintenance and operations tax rate of the
- 12 <u>district for the most recent tax year beginning with the 2007 tax</u>
- 13 year in which the district's tax rate was approved at an election
- 14 under this section; and
- 15 (2) the district's current debt rate.
- SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies to
- 17 the ad valorem tax rate of a school district beginning with the 2009
- 18 tax year, except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section.
- 19 (b) If the governing body of a school district adopted an ad
- 20 valorem tax rate for the school district for the 2009 tax year
- 21 before the effective date of this Act, the change in law made by
- 22 this Act applies to the ad valorem tax rate of that school district
- 23 beginning with the 2010 tax year, and the law in effect when the tax
- 24 rate was adopted applies to the 2009 tax year with respect to that

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- 1 school district.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
