## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to sale of the Texas State Cemetery Annex property (Bull 3 Creek State Cemetery).

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 2165, Government Code, is 6 amended by modifying Section 2165.256(b) to read as follows:

7 (b) [In addition to] The [the] property described as Lot No. 5, Division B, City of Austin, Travis County, Texas[, the following 8 9 property] is dedicated for cemetery purposes as part of the State Cemetery. The following property, also known as the Bull Creek 10 State Cemetery, is dedicated to the State Cemetery for any purpose, 11 12 including sale of fee simple title: BEING 44.07 ACRES OF LAND OUT OF THE GEORGE W. SPEAR LEAGUE IN THE CITY OF AUSTIN, TRAVIS COUNTY, 13 TEXAS, AND BEING OUT OF AND A PORTION OF THAT CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND 14 DESCRIBED BY DEED TO THE STATE OF TEXAS AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 776, 15 PAGE 225, OF THE DEED RECORDS OF TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS. SAID 44.07 16 ACRES OF LAND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: 17

BEGINNING at a set brass cap in concrete for the northwest corner of said State of Texas tract, same being the west corner of Lot 34 of Shoal Village, Section Two, a subdivision in the City of Austin, Texas, as recorded in Book 5, Page 150, of the Plat Records of Travis County, Texas, and being on the east right-of-way line of Bull Creek Road (an existing 60' R/W) and being the northwest corner of this tract;

S 12° 53' 44" E, a distance of 44.69 feet, to a P. 13 14 K. nail set in concrete for the southeast corner of this tract; 15 (4) THENCE N  $62^\circ$  12' 25" W, departing from said Shoal Creek, passing the northeast corner of Lot 24 of Ridgelea, a 16 17 subdivision in the City of Austin, Texas, as recorded in Book 4, Page 258, of the Plat Records of Travis County, Texas, at 59.90 18 feet, a total distance of 414.19 feet to a found 1/2" iron rod under 19 concrete for the most northerly corner of Lot 21 of said Ridgelea 20 subdivision, said point also being a re-entrant corner of this 21 22 tract; THENCE S  $31^{\circ}$  29' 35" W, along the most southerly 23 (5) 24 east line of said State of Texas tract of land, same being the west

24 east line of said state of lexas tract of land, same being the west 25 line of said Ridgelea subdivision, a distance of 715.50 feet to a 26 1/2" iron rod set for a southwest corner of this tract, from this 27 point the northwest corner of Lot 11, same being the southwest

1 corner of Lot 12, of said Ridgelea subdivision bears N 31° 29' 35" E, 2 a distance of 10.64 feet;

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3 (6) THENCE through said State of Texas tract of land4 the following four (4) courses and distances:

5 1. N 23° 52' 33" W, passing a brass cap in concrete
6 set at 5.00 feet, a total distance of 654.65 feet to a brass cap in
7 concrete set for a corner,

8 2. N 06° 26' 42" E, a distance of 308.11 feet, a
9 brass cap in concrete set for a corner,

10 3. N 14° 01' 31" W, a distance of 894.05 feet, a
11 brass cap in concrete set for a corner, and

4. N 63° 17' 00" W, a distance of 478.50 feet to a brass cap set in concrete at the point of intersection with the east right-of-way line of Bull Creek Road, same being the west line of said State of Texas tract of land, and being the most northerly southwest corner of this tract;

17 (7) THENCE N 26° 43' 00" E, along said right-of-way 18 line, a distance of 496.30 feet to the Point of Beginning, and 19 containing 44.07 acres of land, more or less; and

BEING A 2.120 ACRE (92,350 SQUARE FEET) TRACT OF LAND OUT OF THE GEORGE W. SPEAR LEAGUE IN TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS. SAID 2.120 ACRE TRACT OF LAND ALSO BEING OUT OF A 31.12 ACRE TRACT HAVING BEEN CONVEYED TO THE STATE OF TEXAS BY INSTRUMENT OF RECORD IN VOLUME 776, PAGE 225, DEED RECORDS OF TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS. SAID 2.120 ACRE TRACT BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED BY METES AND BOUNDS AS FOLLOWS:

27 BEGINNING, at a brass disk in concrete found on the

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1 southeasterly right of way line of Bull Creek Road. Said disk also 2 being at the northernmost corner of said 31.12 acre tract and the 3 westernmost corner of a 44.07 acre tract also out of the tract 4 described in volume 776, page 225 for the northernmost corner of the 5 herein described tract;

Thence, S63° 17' 00"E, 350.00 feet with the northeasterly line of said 31.12 acre tract and a southwesterly line of said 44.07 acre tract to a 1/2" iron rod set for the easternmost corner of the herein described tract;

10 Thence, S26° 42' 58"W, 205.49 feet with the southeast line of 11 this 2.120 acre tract to a 1/2" iron rod set for the herein 12 described tract, nearby a concrete driveway;

13 Thence, N82° 57' 38"W, 276.95 feet following a concrete 14 driveway to a 1/2" iron rod set for an angle point of the herein 15 described tract;

Thence, N62° 30' 47"W, 89.24 feet continuing along a concrete driveway to a 1/2" iron rod set on the southeasterly right of way line of Bull Creek Road and the westernmost corner of the herein described tract;

THENCE, N26° 43' 00"E, 297.55 feet with the southeasterly line of Bull Creek Road and the northwesterly line of this 2.120 acre tract to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 2.120 acre (92,350 square feet) of land.

In the event the Bull Creek State Cemetery is sold, the committee is authorized to use sale proceeds and any interest that may accrue therefrom to acquire other real property, by purchase or otherwise,

1 <u>suitable for expansion of the State Cemetery, or to accomplish</u>
2 <u>capitol improvements or major repairs or renovation of the existing</u>
3 <u>or new state cemetery grounds.</u>

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4 SECTION 2. All proceeds from the sale of fee simple title to 5 property under Section 2165.256(b) and any interest that accrues therefrom shall be appropriated to the Texas State Cemetery for the 6 7 exclusive use of the State Cemetery to acquire real property in the vicinity of Lot No. 5, Division B, City of Austin, Travis County, 8 Texas or to accomplish capitol improvements or major repairs or 9 10 renovation of the existing or new state cemetery grounds. Any real property acquired with sale proceeds and interest therefrom shall 11 12 be used solely for cemetery purposes as part of the State Cemetery.

13 SECTION 3. In Article I of Senate Bill 1, 81st Leg., R.S., 14 appropriation for the Texas Facilities Commission, insert the 15 following appropriately-numbered rider to read as follows and 16 renumber subsequent riders accordingly:

"\_\_\_\_\_. PROCEEDS FROM SALE OF TEXAS STATE CEMETERY ANNEX. 17 The 18 Texas State Cemetery is appropriated the receipts from the sale of the Bull Creek State Cemetery and any interest that accrues 19 therefrom for the purposes of acquiring other real property to be 20 dedicated for cemetery purposes in the vicinity of the Texas State 21 22 Cemetery and rendering such property suitable for use as a 23 cemetery, or accomplishing capital improvements or major repairs or renovation of the existing or new state cemetery grounds." 24

25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
