A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to special textbooks for the education of blind and
- 3 visually impaired students in public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.028, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) The publisher of an adopted textbook shall provide the
- 9 agency with computerized textbook files for the production of
- 10 Braille textbooks or other versions of textbooks to be used by
- 11 students with disabilities, on request of the State Board of
- 12 Education. A publisher shall arrange computerized textbook files:
- (1) for the production of Braille mathematics or
- 14 science textbooks in LaTeX or Mathematical Markup Language (MathML)
- 15 format unless the board specifies a more recent format; and
- 16 (2) for the production of other versions of textbooks
- 17 to be used by students with disabilities in one of several optional
- 18 formats specified by the <u>board</u> [State Board of Education].
- 19 (c-1) The State Board of Education shall encourage school
- 20 <u>districts and regional education service centers to assist persons</u>
- 21 in developing or improving skills in transcribing textbooks into
- 22 Braille, including offering incentives to those persons.
- SECTION 2. Section 31.028(b), Education Code, as amended by
- 24 this Act, applies to any computerized textbook files for the

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- 1 production of Braille mathematics or science textbooks provided by
- 2 a textbook publisher on or after September 1, 2009.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
