3 <u>(d) The board shall examine whether, consistent with</u> 4 <u>applicable academic standards, it is feasible for institutions of</u> 5 <u>higher education to grant academic credit for all or part of a</u> 6 <u>student's AmeriCorps service, and shall make recommendations for</u> 7 that purpose to institutions consistent with the board's findings.

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
