- 10 (1) "Emergency medical technician" means an
- 11 individual who is certified as an emergency medical technician by
- 12 the Department of State Health Services as provided by Chapter 773,
- 13 Health and Safety Code, and who is a full-time employee of a
- 14 political subdivision.
- 15 (2) "Firefighter" means an individual who is defined
- 16 as fire protection personnel under Section 419.021 and is a
- 17 full-time employee of a political subdivision.
- Sec. 607.102. NOTIFICATION. A firefighter or emergency
- 19 <u>medical technician who is exposed to methicillin-resistant</u>
- 20 Staphylococcus aureus is entitled to receive notification of the
- 21 exposure in the manner prescribed by Section 81.048, Health and
- 22 Safety Code.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
