- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 61.313, Education Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (g-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (g-1) For the purposes of Subsection (a), a private
- 9 postsecondary educational institution that holds a certificate of
- 10 authority issued under Section 61.3035 may use the term "school of
- 11 law" or "law school" in the institution's official name or title.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
- 13 amended by adding Section 61.3035 to read as follows:
- 14 Section 61.3035. EXEMPTION FROM ACCREDITATION FOR CERTAIN
- 15 LAW SCHOOLS. (a) The board by rule shall establish fair and
- 16 reasonable standards for issuing a certificate of authority to a
- 17 private postsecondary educational institution in this state to
- 18 grant degrees for completion of a professional program in the study
- 19 of law.
- 20 (b) The standards under this section must ensure that each
- 21 student attending the institution receives an education that fully
- 22 prepares the student for the practice of law in this state.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 81, Government Code, is
- 24 amended by adding Section 81.062 to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 81.062. ADMISSION OF GRADUATES OF CERTAIN LAW SCHOOLS.
- 2 Notwithstanding any other law, a person who holds a degree granted
- 3 by a law school to which a certificate of authority has been issued
- 4 under Section 61.3035, Education Code, is entitled to the same
- 5 right to admission to the practice of law and to be administered the
- 6 professional licensing examination by the board of law examiners
- 7 under Subchapter B, Chapter 82, as are persons who hold a degree
- 8 granted by an accredited law school in this state.
- 9 SECTION 4. Section 82.0341, Government Code, is amended to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 82.0241. UNACCREDITED SCHOOLS OF LAW; EXCEPTION. All
- 12 matters relating to licensing of persons who were enrolled at
- 13 unaccredited schools of law in this state are within the exclusive
- 14 jurisdiction of the Supreme Court of the State of Texas, except that
- 15 <u>a person who holds a degree granted by a law school to which a</u>
- 16 certificate of authority has been issued under Section 61.3035,
- 17 Education Code, is entitled to the same rights concerning licensing
- 18 as a person who holds a degree granted by an accredited law school.
- 19 SECTION 5. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 20 shall adopt the standards required by Section 61.3035, Education
- 21 Code, as added by this Act, not later than November 1, 2009.
- 22 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
