1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the designation of Farm-to-Market Road 1015 in Hidalgo
1-11 County as the Bill Summers International Boulevard.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is to recognize
1-14 Bill Summers for his unselfish sacrifices in developing a close
1-15 relationship between the Rio Grande Valley and the State of
1-16 Tamaulipas, United Mexican States.

1-17 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subchapter B, Chapter 225,
1-18 Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 225.077 to read
1-19 as follows:

1-20 Sec. 225.077. BILL SUMMERS INTERNATIONAL BOULEVARD. (a)
1-21 Farm-to-Market Road 1015 between U.S. Highway 83 and the Progreso
1-22 International Bridge is designated as the Bill Summers
1-23 International Boulevard.

1-24 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall
1-25 design and construct memorial markers indicating the highway
1-26 number, the designation as the Bill Summers International
1-27 Boulevard, and any other appropriate information.

1-28 (c) The department shall erect a marker at each end of the
1-29 boulevard and at appropriate intermediate sites along the
1-30 boulevard.

1-31 (d) The requirement that a recognized individual be
1-32 deceased under Section 225.001(c) does not apply to this section.

1-33 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
1-34 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
1-35 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
1-36 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
1-37 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
