H.B. No. 4582

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the powers and duties of the Legislative Budget Board, including the receipt of reports by the board. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 316, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 316.010 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 316.010. ADJUSTING THE COMPOSITION OF FUND AND ACCOUNT 7 BALANCES. (a) The comptroller may, as necessary to ensure 8 9 compliance with the limit on the rate of growth of appropriations prescribed by Section 22, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, adjust 10 the composition of fund and account balances without making any net 11 change in the amount of a fund or account balance and without 12 changing the amount of an appropriation. 13 14 (b) The comptroller shall report any adjustment made under Subsection (a) to the Legislative Budget Board. 15 16 SECTION 2. Section 2054.102(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 17 18 The Legislative Budget Board may specify procedures for (a) the submission, review, approval, and disapproval of biennial 19 operating plans and amendments, including procedures for review or 20 21 reconsideration of the Legislative Budget Board's disapproval of a 22 biennial operating plan or biennial operating plan amendment. [The 23 Legislative Budget Board shall review and approve or disapprove the ennial operating plan or biennial operating plan amendment not 24

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later than the 60th day after the date the plan or amendment to the 1 plan is submitted. The plan or amendment to the plan is considered 2 to be approved on the 61st day after the date the plan or amendment 3 is submitted if the Legislative Budget Board does not disapprove 4 5 the plan or amendment before that date. 6 SECTION 3. Section 19.0041, Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 Sec. 19.0041. EVALUATION OF TRAINING SERVICES. 8 (a) То evaluate the effectiveness of training services provided to persons 9 10 confined or imprisoned in the department, the Windham School District shall consult with the Criminal Justice Legislative 11 Oversight Committee [Legislative Budget Board] to compile and 12 analyze information for each person who receives the training 13 14 services. This information shall include an evaluation of: 15 (1) the kind of training services provided; 16 (2) the kind of employment the person obtains on 17 release; (3) whether the employment was related to training; 18 the difference between the amount of the person's 19 (4) earnings on the date employment is obtained following release and 20 the amount of those earnings on the first anniversary of that date; 21 22 and 23 (5) the retention factors associated with the 24 employment. 25 The district [Legislative Budget Board] shall submit an (b) 26 annual report to the Criminal Justice Legislative Oversight Committee, [legislature and] the governor's office, and the 27 2

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3 SECTION 4. Not later than December 1, 2009, the Windham 4 School District shall submit the first report to the Criminal 5 Justice Legislative Oversight Committee, the governor's office, 6 and the Legislative Budget Board as required by Section 19.0041(b), 7 Education Code, as amended by this Act.

8 SECTION 5. Section 322.016(b), Government Code, is 9 repealed.

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SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
