H.B. No. 4594

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to an optional procedure for the issuance of a permit by a certain county for the movement of oversize or overweight vehicles.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 623.252(b)(1) of the Transportation Code is amended to read as follows:

(b) A permit issued under this subchapter may authorize:

(1) the transport of cargo only on the following roads in Chambers County:

(A) Farm-to-Market Road 1405 from its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 2354 to its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 565; and

(B) the frontage road of State Highway 99 located in the Cedar Crossing Business Park; and

(C) Farm-to-Market Road 565 from its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1405 east approximately 6,200 linear feet to the western edge of the 10 foot Pipeline Easement recorded at Volume 351, Page 760 of the Chambers County Deed Records; and

(D) Farm-to-Market Road 2354 from its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1405 northwest to the termination of the state maintained portion of the road approximately 75 to 100 yards from said intersection; and

SECTION 2. Section 623.255(a)(6) of the Transportation Code

1 is amended to read as follows:

2 (6) a statement that the cargo may be transported in
3 Chambers County only over ~~Farm-to-Market Road 1405 and the frontage~~
4 ~~road of State Highway 99 located in the Cedar Crossing Business Park~~
5 those certain roads specified in Section 623.252(b)(1); and

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
10 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
