1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to permits for the movement of oversize and overweight
1-10 vehicles in a certain county.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 623.252(b), Transportation Code, is
1-13 amended to read as follows:

1-14 (b) A permit issued under this subchapter may authorize:

1-15 (1) the transport of cargo only on the following roads
1-16 in Chambers County:

1-17 (A) Farm-to-Market Road 1405 between its
1-18 intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 2354 and its intersection
1-19 with Farm-to-Market Road 565; [and]

1-20 (B) the frontage road of State Highway 99 located
1-21 in the Cedar Crossing Business Park;

1-22 (C) Farm-to-Market Road 565 from its
1-23 intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1405 east approximately
1-24 6,200 linear feet to the western edge of the 10-foot pipeline
1-25 easement recorded at volume 351, page 760, of the Chambers County
1-26 deed records; and

1-27 (D) Farm-to-Market Road 2354 from its
1-28 intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1405 northwest approximately
1-29 300 linear feet to the termination of the state-maintained portion
1-30 of the road; and

1-31 (2) the movement of equipment and commodities weighing
1-32 100,000 pounds or less.

1-33 SECTION 2. Section 623.255(a), Transportation Code, is
1-34 amended to read as follows:

1-35 (a) A permit issued under this subchapter must include:

1-36 (1) the name of the applicant;

1-37 (2) the date of issuance;

1-38 (3) the signature of the designated agent for the
1-39 county;

1-40 (4) a statement of the kind of cargo being
1-41 transported, the maximum weight and dimensions of the equipment,
1-42 and the kind and weight of each commodity to be transported;

1-43 (5) a statement of any condition on which the permit is
1-44 issued;

1-45 (6) a statement that the cargo may be transported in
1-46 Chambers County only over the roads described by Section
1-47 623.252(b)(1) [~~Farm-to-Market Road 1405 and the frontage road of~~
1-48 State Highway 99 located in the Cedar Crossing Business Park]; and

1-49 (7) the location where the cargo was loaded.

1-50 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-51 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-52 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-53 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-54 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
