1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to responsibility and criminal penalties for certain
- 3 violations committed by commercial oyster boat crews.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 76.001, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 76.001. <u>DEFINITIONS</u> [NATURAL OYSTER BED]. <u>In this</u>
- 8 chapter:
- 9 <u>(1) "Barrel of oysters" means three boxes of oysters</u>
- 10 in the shell or two gallons of shucked oysters without shells. The
- 11 dimensions of a box are 10 inches by 20 inches by 13-1/2 inches. In
- 12 filling a box for measurement, the oysters may not be piled more
- 13 than 2-1/2 inches above the height of the box at the center.
- 14 (2) "Natural [(a) A natural] oyster bed" means an
- 15 area where [exists when] at least five barrels of oysters are found
- 16 within 2,500 square feet of any position on a reef or bed.
- 17 (3) "Open season" means a period during which it is
- 18 <u>lawful to take oysters.</u>
- 19 [(b) In this section, a barrel of oysters is equal to three
- 20 boxes of oysters in the shell. The dimensions of a box are 10 inches
- 21 by 20 inches by 13-1/2 inches. In filling a box for measurement,
- 22 the oysters may not be piled more than 2-1/2 inches above the height
- 23 of the box at the center. Two gallons of shucked oysters without
- 24 shells equals one barrel of oysters in the shell.

- 3 (a) There is no open season for taking oysters from areas
- 4 closed by the [Texas] Department of State Health Services.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 76.118, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsections (b), (c), and (e) and adding
- 7 Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) A person who violates Section 76.101, 76.107, or
- 9 76.109[, or 76.116 of this code] or a regulation of the commission
- 10 issued under one of those sections commits an offense that is a
- 11 Class B Parks and Wildlife Code misdemeanor.
- 12 (c) A person who <u>violates Section 76.116</u>, or at the same
- 13 time violates <u>Sections</u> [Section] 76.109 and [either Section]
- 14 $76.116_{\underline{I}}$ [or Section 76.205 of this code] commits an offense that is
- 15 a Class A Parks and Wildlife Code misdemeanor.
- 16 (e) If it is shown at the trial of a defendant for a
- 17 violation of Section 76.101, 76.107, or 76.109[, or 76.116 of this
- 18 code] that the defendant has been convicted once within five years
- 19 before the trial date of a violation of Section 76.101, 76.107, or
- 20 76.109, [or 76.116 of this code,] the defendant is guilty of a Class
- 21 A Parks and Wildlife Code misdemeanor.
- 22 (e-1) If it is shown at the trial of a defendant for a
- 23 violation of Section 76.116 that the defendant has been convicted
- 24 once within five years before the trial date of a violation of
- 25 Section 76.116, the defendant is guilty of a Parks and Wildlife Code
- 26 state jail felony.
- 27 SECTION 4. Section 76.119(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is

- 1 amended to read as follows:
- 2 (a) If a vessel licensed as a commercial oyster boat is
- 3 involved in a violation of this chapter, the captain of the vessel
- 4 licensed as a commercial oyster boat is primarily responsible for
- 5 the violation. A member of the crew of a vessel licensed as a
- 6 commercial oyster boat is not guilty of a violation unless the
- 7 member of the crew committed the violation against the captain's
- 8 orders, except for a violation of Section 76.109 or 76.116 [of this
- 9 subchapter], in which case each person on the vessel is responsible
- 10 for the violation.
- 11 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 12 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 13 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 14 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed. For
- 15 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 16 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 17 before that date.
- 18 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
