- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.425, Transportation Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 545.425. USE OF WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICE [BY
- 8 CERTAIN MOTORISTS]. (a) In this section, "hands-free device"
- 9 means speakerphone capability or a telephone attachment or other
- 10 piece of equipment, regardless of whether permanently installed in
- 11 the motor vehicle, that allows use of the wireless communication
- 12 device without use of either of the operator's hands.
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), an operator of a
- 14 commercial motor vehicle, as defined by Section 522.003, may not
- 15 use a wireless communication device while operating the vehicle
- 16 unless:

- 17 (1) the vehicle is stopped;
- 18 (2) the wireless communication device is used with a
- 19 <u>hands-free device; or</u>
- 20 (3) the wireless communication device is used as part
- 21 of a digital dispatch system or global positioning satellite
- 22 location system.
- 23 (c) An operator [A person] may not use a wireless
- 24 communication device while operating a passenger bus with a minor

- 1 passenger on the bus <u>unless</u> [except in case of emergency or if] the
- 2 passenger bus is stopped [not in motion].
- 3 (d) This section does not apply if:
- 4 (1) the operator is a peace officer or an emergency
- 5 <u>response provider; and</u>
- 6 (2) the use of the wireless communication device is in
- 7 <u>connection with official duties.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 10 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 11 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 12 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 13 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 14 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 15 committed before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
