5	SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter D, Chapter 87,
6	Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

9	SECTION 2. Section 87.301, Education Code, is amended to

12	<pre>UniversityKingsville] is a coeducational institution of higher</pre>
13	education located in the city of Kingsville. The university is a
14	component institution of The Texas A&M University System and is
15	under the management and control of the board of regents of The
16	Texas A&M University System.
17	(b) The board has the same powers and duties concerning
18	Texas <u>A&I University</u> [A&M UniversityKingsville] as are conferred
19	on it by statute concerning Texas A&M University.
20	SECTION 3. Subdivision (1), Section 51.502, Education Code,
21	is amended to read as follows:
22	(1) "Eligible institution" means the college,

8 SECTION 5. Subsection (c), Section 85.70, Education Code, 9 is amended to read as follows:

(c) The board shall lease for oil, gas, sulphur, or other 10 mineral development, as prescribed by this subchapter, all or part 11 of the land under the exclusive control of the board owned by the 12 State of Texas and acquired for the use of Texas A&I University [A&M 13 14 University--Kingsville] and its divisions. Any money received by 15 the board concerning such land under this subchapter shall be deposited in the state treasury to the credit of a special fund to 16 17 be known as the Texas A&I University [A&M University--Kingsville] special mineral fund, to be used exclusively for Texas A&I 18 19 University [A&M University--Kingsville] and its branches and Money may not be expended from this fund except as 20 divisions. authorized by the general appropriations act. 21

22 SECTION 6. (a) A reference in law to Texas A&M 23 University--Kingsville means Texas A&I University.

(b) An appropriation for the use and benefit of Texas A&M
25 University--Kingsville is available for the use and benefit of
26 Texas A&I University.
