2	relating to the authority of a county or municipality to regulate

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 91, Natural Resources Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter R to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER R. REGULATION BY COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY OF DRILLING OF
8	OIL AND GAS WELLS
9	Sec. 91.801. ADOPTION BY COMMISSION OF MODEL COUNTY OF
10	MUNICIPAL RULES. (a) The commission shall prepare and adopt model
11	rules for adoption by a county and model rules for adoption by a
12	municipality regulating the drilling of oil and gas wells in the
13	county or municipality, respectively.
14	(b) The model rules must promote:
15	(1) the health, safety, morals, and general welfare of
16	the county or municipality adopting the model rules; and
17	(2) the safe, orderly, and healthful development of
18	the county or municipality adopting the model rules.
19	Sec. 91.802. COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL REGULATION OF DRILLING OF
20	OIL AND GAS WELLS. (a) A county by order or a municipality by
21	ordinance may regulate the drilling of oil and gas wells in the
22	<pre>county or municipality, respectively, if:</pre>
23	(1) the county or municipality is authorized to do so
24	under other law; and

- 1 (2) except as provided by Subsection (b), the order or
- 2 ordinance is consistent with the applicable model rules adopted by
- 3 the commission under Section 91.801.
- 4 (b) A county or municipality may adopt an order or
- 5 ordinance, respectively, that conflicts with the applicable model
- 6 rules adopted by the commission under Section 91.801 only if the
- 7 commission after a hearing determines that the county or
- 8 municipality has shown that, because of circumstances specific to
- 9 the county or municipality, the public interest necessitates
- 10 authorizing the county or municipality to adopt the conflicting
- 11 order or ordinance.
- 12 SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective
- 13 date of this Act, the Railroad Commission of Texas shall adopt model
- 14 rules under Section 91.801, Natural Resources Code, as added by
- 15 this Act.
- 16 (b) An order adopted by a county or an ordinance adopted by a
- 17 municipality before the effective date of this Act regulating the
- 18 drilling of oil and gas wells remains in effect until the model
- 19 rules adopted by the Railroad Commission of Texas under Section
- 20 91.801, Natural Resources Code, as added by this Act, take effect.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
