- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 56.34 of the Code of Criminal Procedure
- 5 is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Art. 56.34. COMPENSATION. (a) The attorney general shall
- 7 award compensation for pecuniary loss arising from criminally
- 8 injurious conduct if the attorney general is satisfied by a
- 9 preponderance of the evidence that the requirements of this
- 10 subchapter are met.
- 11 (b) The attorney general, shall establish whether, as a
- 12 direct result of criminally injurious conduct, a claimant or victim
- 13 suffered personal injury or death or suffered severe financial
- 14 hardship from a fraudulent financial scheme that resulted in a
- 15 pecuniary loss for which the claimant or victim is not compensated
- 16 from a collateral source.
- 17 SECTION 2. Chapter 56.42 of the Code of Criminal Procedure
- 18 is amended as follows by adding subsection (f):
- 19 (f) the limits of awards payable to victims of a fraudulent
- 20 financial scheme shall not be less than the losses to the victim
- 21 from that fraudulent financial scheme.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
