 administer this chapter.

3 SECTION 4. Section 520.036, Transportation Code, is 4 transferred to Subchapter B, Chapter 520, Transportation Code, and 5 renumbered as Section 520.026, Transportation Code, to read as 6 follows:

Sec. <u>520.026</u> [<u>520.036</u>]. GENERAL PENALTY. (a) A person
commits an offense if the person violates this subchapter in a
manner for which a specific penalty is not provided.

10 (b) An offense under this section is a misdemeanor 11 punishable by a fine of not less than \$50 and not more than \$200.

SECTION 5. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after September 1, 2009.

(b) An offense committed before September 1, 2009, is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this subsection, an offense was committed before September 1, 2009, if any element of the offense was committed before that date.

19 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
