- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 28.022(a) is amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) The board of trustees of each school district shall adopt a
- 6 policy that:
- 7 (1) provides for a conference between parents and
- 8 teachers;
- 9 (2) requires the district, at least once every 12
- 10 weeks, to give written notice to a parent of a student's performance
- 11 in each class or subject <u>and of a student's grade level performance</u>
- 12 <u>in reading;</u> and
- 13 (3) requires the district, at least once every three
- 14 weeks, or during the fourth week of each nine-week grading period,
- 15 to give written notice to a parent or legal guardian of a student's
- 16 performance in a subject included in the foundation curriculum
- 17 under Section 28.002(a)(1) if the student's performance in the
- 18 subject is consistently unsatisfactory, as determined by the
- 19 district.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2010.
