H.B. No. 4712

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to the powers and duties of the Collin County Municipal  
3 Utility District No. 1.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 8164, Special District  
6 Local Laws Code, as added by Chapter 1067 (H.B. No. 2442), Acts of  
7 the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, is amended by adding  
8 Section 8164.055 to read as follows:

9 Sec. 8164.055. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) Subject to this  
10 section, the district may divide into two or more districts as  
11 provided by Sections 51.748, 51.749, 51.750, 51.751, 51.752, and  
12 51.753, Water Code. For the purpose of applying those sections, the  
13 district shall be considered an original district and a reference  
14 to "this chapter" shall be considered a reference to Chapter 54,  
15 Water Code.

16 (b) On petition of any district landowner or on a motion by  
17 the district's board of directors, the board may consider a  
18 proposal to divide the district.

19 (c) No division of the district may occur that would result  
20 in the creation of a new district that contains land outside of the  
21 boundaries of the district as it existed on January 1, 2009.

22 (d) Section 54.016, Water Code, and Section 42.042, Local  
23 Government Code, do not apply to any new district created by the  
24 division of the district.

1           SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
5 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
