5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 4, Special District Local Laws
7	Code, is amended by adding Chapter 3871 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 3871. TRINITY RIVER WEST MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT DISTRICT
9	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
10	Sec. 3871.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
11	(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.
12	(2) "City" means the City of Dallas.
13	(3) "District" means the Trinity River West Municipal
14	Management District.
15	(4) "Improvement project" means a project authorized
16	by Section 3871.102:
17	(A) inside the boundaries of the district; and
18	(B) in areas outside but adjacent to the
19	boundaries of the district if the project is for the purpose of
20	extending public infrastructure improvements beyond the district's
21	boundaries to a logical terminus.
22	Sec. 3871.002. CREATION AND NATURE OF DISTRICT. The
23	district is a special district created under Section 59, Article
24	XVI, Texas Constitution.

Sec. 3871.003. PURPOSE; LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. (a) The 1 2 creation of the district is essential to accomplish the purposes of Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI, 3 Texas Constitution, and other public purposes stated in this 4 5 chapter. By creating the district and in authorizing the city and other political subdivisions to contract with the district, the 6 7 legislature has established a program to accomplish the public purposes set out in Section 52-a, Article III, Texas Constitution. 8 9 (b) The creation of the district is necessary to promote, 10 develop, encourage, and maintain employment, commerce, transportation, housing, tourism, recreation, the arts, 11 12 entertainment, economic development, safety, the public welfare in the district, and educational scholarships for college-bound 13 students residing in or out of the district. 14 15 (c) The district is created to supplement and not to supplant city services provided in the district. 16 17 Sec. 3871.004. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE. (a) The district is created to serve a public use and benefit. 18 19 (b) All land and other property included in the district

20 will benefit from the improvements and services to be provided by 21 the district under powers conferred by Sections 52 and 52-a, 22 Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and 23 other powers granted under this chapter.

24 (c) The creation of the district is in the public interest
 25 and is essential to further the public purposes of:

26 (1) developing and diversifying the economy of the 27 state;

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1	(2) eliminating unemployment and underemployment;
2	(3) developing or expanding transportation and
3	commerce; and
4	(4) providing quality residential housing.
5	(d) The district will:
6	(1) promote the health, safety, and general welfare of
7	residents, employers, potential employees, employees, visitors,
8	and consumers in the district, and of the public;
9	(2) provide needed funding for the district to
10	preserve, maintain, and enhance the economic health and vitality of
11	the district territory as a residential community and business
12	<pre>center;</pre>
13	(3) promote the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment
14	of the public by providing pedestrian ways and by landscaping and
15	developing certain areas in the district, which are necessary for
16	the restoration, preservation, and enhancement of scenic beauty;
17	and
18	(4) provide educational scholarships for
19	college-bound students residing in or out of the district.
20	(e) Pedestrian ways along or across a street, whether at
21	grade or above or below the surface, and street lighting, street
22	landscaping, vehicle parking, and street art objects are parts of
23	and necessary components of a street and are considered to be an
24	improvement project that includes a street or road improvement.
25	(f) The district will not act as the agent or
26	instrumentality of any private interest even though the district
27	will benefit many private interests as well as the public.

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1	Sec. 3871.005. DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The district is
2	composed of the territory described by Section 2 of the Act creating
3	this chapter, as that territory may have been modified under
4	Section 3871.106.
5	(b) A mistake in the field notes of the district contained
6	in Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter or in copying the
7	field notes in the legislative process does not in any way affect:
8	(1) the district's organization, existence, or
9	validity;
10	(2) the district's right to contract, including the
11	right to issue any type of bond or other obligation for a purpose
12	for which the district is created;
13	(3) the district's right to impose or collect an
14	assessment, tax, or any other revenue; or
15	(4) the legality or operation of the board.
16	Sec. 3871.006. ELIGIBILITY FOR INCLUSION IN SPECIAL ZONES.
17	(a) All or any part of the area of the district is eligible to be
18	included in:
19	(1) a tax increment reinvestment zone created by the
20	city under Chapter 311, Tax Code;
21	(2) a tax abatement reinvestment zone created by the
22	city under Chapter 312, Tax Code; or
23	(3) an enterprise zone created by the city under
24	Chapter 2303, Government Code.
25	(b) If the city creates a tax increment reinvestment zone
26	described by Subsection (a), the city and the board of directors of
27	the zone, by contract with the district, may grant money deposited

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1	in the tax increment fund to the district to be used by the district
2	for the purposes permitted for money granted to a corporation under
3	Section 380.002(b), Local Government Code, including the right to
4	pledge the money as security for any bonds issued by the district
5	for an improvement project. A project may not receive public funds
6	under Section 380.002(b), Local Government Code, unless the project
7	has been approved by the governing body of the city by the adoption
8	of a resolution.
9	(c) A tax increment reinvestment zone created by the city in
10	the district is not subject to the limitations provided by Section
11	<u>311.006(b), Tax Code.</u>
12	[Sections 3871.007-3871.050 reserved for expansion]
13	SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS
14	Sec. 3871.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is
15	governed by a board of nine directors composed of:
16	(1) six directors appointed by the governing body of
17	the city; and
18	(2) three city employees appointed by the governing
19	body of the city.
20	(b) Directors serve staggered terms of four years, with four
21	or five directors' terms expiring July 1 of each odd-numbered year.
22	Sec. 3871.052. APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS: BOARD MEETINGS.
23	(a) Directors appointed under Section 3871.051(a)(1) must meet at
24	least one of the qualifications prescribed by Section 3871.053.
25	(b) A person may not be appointed to the board if the
26	appointment of that person would result in fewer than:
27	(1) four of the directors being residents of the city

1	and meeting the qualifications prescribed by Section
2	3871.053(a)(2), (3), (4), or (5); and
3	(2) two of the directors meeting the qualifications
4	<pre>prescribed by Section 3871.053(a)(1).</pre>
5	(c) The governing body of the city may remove a member of the
6	board with or without cause at any time by a majority vote.
7	(d) The board shall hold meetings at a place accessible to
8	the public. The board shall file a copy of the notice of a meeting
9	with the city's secretary. The city's secretary shall post the
10	notice at Dallas City Hall.
11	(e) The board may not create an executive committee to
12	exercise the powers of the board.
13	Sec. 3871.053. QUALIFICATIONS OF DIRECTORS. (a) To be
14	qualified to serve as a director appointed under Section
15	3871.051(a)(1), a person must be at least 18 years old and must be:
16	(1) a resident of the district who is also a registered
17	voter of the district or a registered voter who lives within a
18	two-mile radius of the district;
19	(2) an owner of property in the district;
20	(3) an owner of stock, whether beneficial or
21	otherwise, of a corporate owner of property in the district;
22	(4) an owner of a beneficial interest in a trust that
23	owns property in the district; or
24	(5) an agent, employee, or tenant of a person covered
25	by Subdivision (2), (3), or (4).
26	(b) Section 49.052, Water Code, does not apply to the
27	<u>district.</u>

Sec. 3871.054. VACANCY. The governing body of the city
 shall fill a vacancy on the board by appointing a person who meets
 the qualifications prescribed by Section 3871.051(a) or 3871.053 to
 serve for the remainder of the unexpired term.

5 <u>Sec. 3871.055. DIRECTOR'S OATH OR AFFIRMATION. A</u> 6 director's oath or affirmation of office shall be filed with the 7 district and the district shall retain the oath or affirmation in 8 the district records. A copy of each director's oath or affirmation 9 of office shall be filed with the city's secretary.

10 <u>Sec. 3871.056. OFFICERS. The board shall elect from among</u> 11 <u>the directors a chair, a vice chair, and a secretary. The offices</u> 12 <u>of chair and secretary may not be held by the same person</u> 13 <u>concurrently.</u>

14Sec. 3871.057. COMPENSATION; EXPENSES; LIABILITY INSURANCE15FOR DIRECTORS. (a) The district may compensate each director in an16amount not to exceed \$50 for each board meeting. The total amount17of compensation for each director in one year may not exceed \$2,000.18(b) Directors are entitled to reimbursement for necessary19and reasonable expenses incurred in carrying out the duties and20responsibilities of the board.

21 (c) The district may obtain and pay for comprehensive 22 general liability insurance coverage from a commercial insurance 23 company or other source that protects and insures a director 24 against personal liability and from any and all claims relating to: 25 (1) actions taken by the director in the director's 26 capacity as a member of the board;

27

(2) actions and activities taken by the district; or

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1	(3) the actions of others acting on behalf of the
2	district.
3	Sec. 3871.058. CONFLICTS OF INTEREST. (a) A director,
4	including a director who qualifies under Section 3871.053(a)(2),
5	(3), (4), or (5), may participate in all board votes and decisions
6	if the director complies with the requirements of Subsection (b).
7	(b) A director shall comply with Section 171.004, Local
8	Government Code, including the disclosure and abstention
9	requirements of that section. A director must file a copy of the
10	director's disclosure affidavit required by Section 171.004, Local
11	Government Code, with the city's secretary before participating in
12	a board discussion or vote.
13	Sec. 3871.059. INITIAL DIRECTORS. (a) The initial board
14	consists of the following directors:
15	(1) Place 1: a director who qualifies under Section
16	3871.053(a)(2), (3), (4), or (5);
17	(2) Place 2: a director who qualifies under Section
18	3871.053(a)(2), (3), (4), or (5);
19	(3) Place 3: a director who qualifies under Section
20	3871.053(a)(2), (3), (4), or (5);
21	(4) Place 4: a director who qualifies under Section
22	<u>3871.053(a)(1);</u>
23	(5) Place 5: a director who qualifies under Section
24	<u>3871.053(a)(1);</u>
25	(6) Place 6: a director who qualifies under Section
26	<u>3871.053(a)(2), (3), (4), or (5);</u>
27	(7) Place 7: a city employee;

1	(8) Place 8: a city employee; and
2	(9) Place 9: a city employee.
3	(b) Not later than September 1, 2009, the owner or owners of
4	a majority of the appraised value of the real property in the
5	district, or the majority of the record owners of real property in
6	the district subject to taxation, may submit a petition to the
7	governing body of the city requesting that the governing body
8	appoint as initial directors the persons named in the petition to
9	serve in Places 1-6. If the persons named in the petition meet the
10	qualifications prescribed by Sections 3871.052 and 3871.053, the
11	governing body may appoint those persons as initial directors under
12	Subsection (a) to serve in Places 1-6.
13	(c) If a petition is not submitted under Subsection (b), the
14	governing body of the city shall appoint as initial directors six
15	persons who meet the qualifications prescribed by Sections 3871.052
16	and 3871.053 to serve in Places 1-6.
17	(d) Of the initial directors, the terms of directors
18	appointed for Places 1, 2, 3, and 4 expire July 1, 2011, and the
19	terms of directors appointed for Places 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9 expire
20	July 1, 2013.
21	(e) This section expires September 1, 2013.
22	[Sections 3871.060-3871.100 reserved for expansion]
23	SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES
24	Sec. 3871.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has
25	the powers and duties provided by this chapter and by:
26	(1) the general laws relating to conservation and
27	reclamation districts created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas

1	Constitution, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code;
2	(2) Chapter 441, Transportation Code, except that:
3	(A) the district may exercise any power granted
4	by this chapter without regard to any provision or requirement of or
5	procedure prescribed by Chapter 441, Transportation Code; and
6	(B) the district may not build or operate a toll
7	road;
8	(3) Subchapter A, Chapter 372, Local Government Code,
9	in the same manner as a municipality or a county;
10	(4) Chapter 1371, Government Code;
11	(5) Chapter 375, Local Government Code; and
12	(6) Chapter 311, Tax Code.
13	Sec. 3871.102. IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. (a) The district may
14	provide, or it may enter into contracts with a governmental or
15	private entity to provide, the following types of improvement
16	projects located in the district or activities in support of or
17	incidental to those projects:
18	(1) a supply and distribution facility or system to
19	provide potable and nonpotable water to the residents and
20	businesses of the district, including a wastewater collection
21	facility;
22	(2) a paved, macadamized, or graveled road or street,
23	inside and outside the district, to the full extent authorized by
24	Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution;
25	(3) the planning, design, construction, improvement,
26	and maintenance of:
27	(A) landscaping;

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1	(B) highway right-of-way or transit corridor
2	beautification and improvement;
3	(C) lighting, banners, and signs;
4	(D) a street or sidewalk;
5	(E) a hiking and cycling path or trail;
6	(F) a pedestrian walkway, skywalk, crosswalk, or
7	<pre>tunnel;</pre>
8	(G) a park, lake, garden, recreational facility,
9	community activities center, dock, wharf, sports facility, open
10	space, scenic area, or related exhibit or preserve;
11	(H) a fountain, plaza, or pedestrian mall; or
12	(I) a drainage or storm-water detention
13	<pre>improvement;</pre>
14	(4) protection and improvement of the quality of storm
15	water that flows through the district;
16	(5) the planning, design, construction, improvement,
17	maintenance, and operation of:
18	(A) a water or sewer facility; or
19	(B) an off-street parking facility or heliport;
20	(6) the planning and acquisition of:
21	(A) public art and sculpture and related exhibits
22	and facilities; or
23	(B) an educational facility, and a cultural
24	exhibit or facility;
25	(7) the planning, design, construction, acquisition,
26	lease, rental, improvement, maintenance, installation, and
27	management of and provision of furnishings for a facility for:

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(A) a conference, convention, or exhibition;
(B) a manufacturer, consumer, or trade show;
(C) a civic, community, or institutional event;
or
(D) an exhibit, display, attraction, special
event, or seasonal or cultural celebration or holiday;
(8) the removal, razing, demolition, or clearing of
land or improvements in connection with improvement projects;
(9) the acquisition and improvement of land or other
property for the mitigation of the environmental effects of an
improvement project if those costs are incurred in accordance with
a development agreement and reimbursement of those costs is
conditioned on the completion of substantial vertical development,
or the costs are related to a transit or mobility project;
(10) the acquisition of property or an interest in
property in connection with one or more authorized improvement
projects, including a project authorized by Subchapter A, Chapter
372, Local Government Code;
(11) a special or supplemental service for the
improvement and promotion of the district or an area adjacent to the
district or for the protection of public health and safety in or
adjacent to the district, including:
(A) advertising;
(B) promotion;
(C) tourism;
(D) health and sanitation;
(E) public safety;

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1	(F) security;
2	(G) fire protection or emergency medical
3	services;
4	(H) business recruitment;
5	(I) elimination of traffic congestion, including
6	by use of rail services;
7	(J) recreational, educational, or cultural
8	improvements, enhancements, and services; and
9	(K) creation and financing of a higher education
10	scholarship fund for students attending Mountain View College or
11	the University of North Texas (Dallas Campus); or
12	(12) any similar public improvement, facility, or
13	service.
14	(b) The district may not undertake an improvement project
15	under this section unless the board determines the project to be
16	necessary to accomplish a public purpose of the district and has
17	received the approval of the city under Section 3871.160.
18	(c) An improvement project must comply with any applicable
19	codes and ordinances of the city.
20	(d) The district may not provide, conduct, or authorize an
21	improvement project on the city streets, highways, rights-of-way,
22	or easements without the consent of the governing body of the city.
23	(e) Subject to an agreement between the district and the
24	city, the city may:
25	(1) by ordinance, order, or resolution require that
26	title to all or any portion of an improvement project vest in the
27	city; or

H.B. No. 4720 (2) unless prohibited by Subsection (h), by ordinance, 1 order, resolution, or other directive, authorize the district to 2 own, encumber, maintain, and operate an improvement project, 3 subject to the right of the city to order a conveyance of the 4 5 improvement project to the city on a date determined by the city. 6 The district shall immediately comply with any city (f) 7 ordinance, order, or resolution adopted under Subsection (e). For the purposes of this section, planning, design, 8 (g) construction, improvement, and maintenance of a lake includes work 9 done for drainage, reclamation, or recreation. 10 (h) Waterworks and sanitary sewer improvements may be 11 12 undertaken by the district inside or outside the boundaries of the district, subject to the following conditions: 13 14 (1) the city shall request that waterworks or sanitary 15 sewer improvements be funded by the district; (2) the city shall construct, own, operate, and 16 17 maintain the improvements; and (3) the district shall comply with Sections 3871.152, 18 19 3871.157, and 3871.160 as a condition for the district to fund the 20 improvements. 21 Sec. 3871.103. GENERAL POWERS REGARDING CONTRACTS. (a) The district may: 22 23 (1) contract with any person to accomplish any 24 district purpose, including a contract for: 25 (A) the payment, repayment, or reimbursement of 26 costs incurred by that person on behalf of the district, including all or part of the costs of any improvement project and interest on 27

1 the reimbursed cost; or 2 (B) the use, occupancy, lease, rental, 3 operation, maintenance, or management of all or part of a proposed 4 or existing improvement project; and 5 (2) apply for and contract with any person to receive, administer, and perform a duty or obligation of the district under a 6 7 federal, state, local, or private gift, grant, loan, conveyance, transfer, bequest, or other financial assistance arrangement 8 relating to the investigation, planning, analysis, study, design, 9 10 acquisition, construction, improvement, completion, implementation, or operation by the district or others of a 11 12 proposed or existing improvement project. (b) A contract the district enters into to carry out a 13 purpose of this chapter may be on any terms and for any period the 14 board determines, including a negotiable or nonnegotiable note or 15 warrant payable to the city, Dallas County, or any other person. 16 17 (c) Any person may contract with the district to carry out the purposes of this chapter without further statutory or other 18 19 authorization. 20 (d) The district must follow Resolution 08-2826, adopted by the city on October 22, 2008, for construction, procurement, and 21 22 professional services contracts related to the use of historically underutilized businesses and minority contracting in the 23 24 implementation of its district plan. 25 Sec. 3871.104. RULES; ENFORCEMENT. (a) The district may 26 adopt rules: 27 (1) to administer or operate the district;

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1	(2) for the use, enjoyment, availability, protection,
2	security, and maintenance of the district's property and
3	facilities; or
4	(3) to provide for public safety and security in the
5	district.
6	(b) The district may enforce its rules by injunctive relief.
7	(c) To the extent a district rule conflicts with a city
8	rule, order, or regulation, the city rule, order, or regulation
9	<u>controls.</u>
10	(d) The district shall provide the city with written notice
11	not later than the 30th day before the date of a meeting at which the
12	board will adopt rules. The district may not adopt a rule affecting
13	the use of a municipally owned asset, such as a public park, street,
14	sidewalk, transit facility, or public right-of-way, unless the
15	governing body of the city has approved the rule by ordinance,
16	order, or resolution.
17	Sec. 3871.105. NAME CHANGE. The board by resolution may
18	change the district's name. The board shall give written notice of
19	the change to the city.
20	Sec. 3871.106. ADDING OR REMOVING TERRITORY. The board may
21	add or remove territory under Subchapter J, Chapter 49, Water Code,
22	and Section 54.016, Water Code, except that:
23	(1) the addition or removal of the territory must be
24	approved by:
25	(A) the governing body of the city by ordinance,
26	order, or resolution; and
27	(B) the owners of the territory being added or

1	removed;
2	(2) a reference to a tax in Subchapter J, Chapter 49,
3	Water Code, or Section 54.016, Water Code, means an ad valorem tax;
4	and
5	(3) territory may not be removed from the district if
6	bonds or other obligations of the district payable wholly or partly
7	from ad valorem taxes or assessments levied or assessed on the
8	territory are outstanding.
9	Sec. 3871.107. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. (a) The district may
10	create economic development and other programs under Section 52-a,
11	Article III, Texas Constitution, and may impose and collect ad
12	valorem taxes for those purposes. The district has the economic
13	development powers that Chapter 380, Local Government Code,
14	provides to a municipality with a population of more than 100,000.
15	Each economic development program and each project that will
16	receive public funds under an economic development program must be
17	approved by the governing body of the city by ordinance, order, or
18	resolution.
19	(b) The district shall provide the city written notice not
20	later than the 30th day before the date of a meeting at which the
21	board will adopt terms of an economic development program. The
22	district may not adopt an economic development program or
23	improvement project to be funded under an economic development
24	program unless the governing body of the city has approved the
25	program or improvement project by ordinance, order, or resolution.
26	Sec. 3871.108. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
27	not exercise the power of eminent domain.

Sec. 3871.109. TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT; COMPENSATION. The board may employ and establish the terms of employment and compensation of an executive director or general manager and any other district employees the board considers necessary. An employee may not receive annual compensation of more than \$150,000 from public funds of the district.

7 Sec. 3871.110. NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS. (a) The board 8 shall annually provide owners of real property in the district written notice that specifies the tax of the district for the 9 10 district's next fiscal year in sufficient clarity to describe the tax rate for the operation and maintenance of the district and the 11 12 tax rate for the payment of debt service of obligations issued or incurred by the district. The written notice must be sent by first 13 class United States mail, postage prepaid, to the current address 14 of the property owner as reflected on the tax rolls of the appraisal 15 16 district.

17 (b) The notice must clearly state that the tax rates on real 18 property imposed in the district are in addition to the ad valorem 19 taxes imposed by other taxing units that tax real property in the 20 boundaries of the district.

21 (c) The district shall generate and implement a program to 22 provide notification to a prospective purchaser of property in the 23 district of the rates of tax and assessments that have been approved 24 and are imposed by the district.

26	SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS
27	Sec. 3871.151. GENERAL POWERS REGARDING FINANCIAL MATTERS.

1	(a) Except as provided by Section 3871.160, the district may:
2	(1) impose an ad valorem tax on all taxable industrial
3	and commercial property in the district to pay for any improvement
4	projects of the types authorized by Section 52(b), Article III, and
5	Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and to secure the
6	payment of bonds issued for those purposes;
7	(2) impose an assessment on property in the district
8	to pay the cost of any authorized improvement project and the cost
9	of the maintenance of the project in the manner provided for:
10	(A) a district under Subchapters A, E, and F,
11	Chapter 375, Local Government Code; or
12	(B) a municipality or county under Subchapter A,
13	Chapter 372, Local Government Code;
14	(3) provide or secure the payment or repayment of any
15	bond, note, or other temporary or permanent obligation or
16	reimbursement or other contract with any person, the costs and
17	expenses of the establishment, administration, and operation of the
18	district, and the district's costs or share of the costs or revenue
19	of an improvement project or district contractual obligation or
20	indebtedness by or through:
21	(A) the imposition of an ad valorem tax,
22	assessment, user fee, concession fee, or rental charge; and
23	(B) any other revenue or resources of the
24	district, or other revenue authorized by the city, including
25	revenue from a tax increment reinvestment zone created by the city
26	under applicable law;
27	(4) establish user charges related to the operation of

storm-water facilities, including the regulation of storm water for 1 the protection of water quality in the district; 2 3 (5) establish user charges for the use of nonpotable water for irrigation purposes, subject to the approval of the 4 5 governing body of the city; 6 (6) undertake separately or jointly with other 7 persons, including the city or Dallas County, all or part of the 8 cost of any improvement project, including an improvement project: (A) for improving, enhancing, and supporting 9 public safety and security, fire protection and emergency medical 10 services, and law enforcement in and adjacent to the district; or 11 12 (B) that confers a general benefit on the entire district or a special benefit on a definable part of the district; 13 14 and 15 (7) enter into a tax abatement agreement in accordance with the general laws of this state authorizing and applicable to 16 17 tax abatement agreements by municipalities. (b) The district may not impose an ad valorem tax to pay for 18 19 an improvement project under this chapter unless the imposition is approved by the voters of the district voting at an election held 20 for that purpose. The board may call an election to approve the 21 imposition of an ad valorem tax to pay for an improvement project 22 under this chapter only if the board receives a petition requesting 23 24 the election signed by: 25 (1) more than 65 percent of the record owners of real 26 property in the district subject to taxation; or 27 (2) owners representing more than 65 percent of the

(a) The district may 3 borrow money for a district purpose by issuing or executing bonds, 4 5 notes, credit agreements, or other obligations of any kind found by the board to be necessary or appropriate for any district purpose. 6 7 The bond, note, credit agreement, or other obligation may be secured by and payable from ad valorem taxes, assessments, a 8 combination of ad valorem taxes and assessments, or other district 9 revenue. The governing body of the city must approve the issuance 10 of bonds, notes, credit agreements, or other obligations of the 11 12 district, in general terms before the preparation of preliminary official statements or loan closing documents, as provided by the 13 development and operating agreement approved by the city in 14 15 accordance with Section 3871.160, or by separate action. 14 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to 15 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 16 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 17 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 18 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 19 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 20 Government Code.

(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

(c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives within the required time.

1 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 2 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 3 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 4 and accomplished.

5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
