4 (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the 5 effective date of this Act:

6 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation 7 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final court 8 judgment; or

(2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment.

10 SECTION 3. The permits described by Section 2(a) of this Act 11 were regular permits issued by the Edwards Aquifer Authority as of 12 January 1, 2005, and the withdrawals authorized by those permits as 13 they were originally issued were included within the 572,000 14 acre-feet of water for each calendar year established by Section 15 1.14(c), Chapter 626, Acts of the 73rd Legislature, Regular 16 Session, 1993.

17 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 18 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 19 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 20 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 21 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 22 Government Code. 23

(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
 Environmental Quality.

(c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed

1 its recommendations on this Act with the governor, the lieutenant 2 governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives within 3 the required time.

4 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
5 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
6 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
7 and accomplished.

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
