A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the election of the board of directors of the Crockett
3	County Water Control and Improvement District.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle I, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
6	Code, is amended by adding Chapter 9035 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 9035. CROCKETT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT
8	DISTRICT
9	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
10	Sec. 9035.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
11	(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.
12	(2) "Director" means a board member.
13	(3) "District" means the Crockett County Water Control
14	and Improvement District.
15	[Sections 9035.002-9035.050 reserved for expansion]
16	SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS
17	Sec. 9035.051. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. (a) Notwithstanding
18	Section 49.103(b), Water Code, on the uniform election date in
19	November of each even-numbered year, the district shall hold an
20	election to elect the appropriate number of directors to the board.
21	(b) The election may be held at any location that is in the
22	boundaries of:
23	(1) the district; and
24	(2) Crockett County.

- 1 SECTION 2. (a) All governmental acts and proceedings of the
- 2 Crockett County Water Control and Improvement District relating to
- 3 the election of members of the board of directors of the district
- 4 that were taken before the effective date of this Act are validated,
- 5 ratified, and confirmed in all respects as if they had been taken as
- 6 authorized by law.
- 7 (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the
- 8 effective date of this Act:
- 9 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation
- 10 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final court
- 11 judgment; or
- 12 (2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment.
- 13 SECTION 3. A director of the board of the Crockett County
- 14 Water Control and Improvement District who is serving on the day
- 15 before the effective date of this Act shall serve until the
- 16 director's term expires. A director whose term expires in May 2010
- 17 shall serve until the director's successor has qualified following
- 18 the directors' election held on the uniform election date in
- 19 November 2010 in accordance with Section 9035.051, Special District
- 20 Local Laws Code, as added by this Act. A director whose term
- 21 expires in May 2012 shall serve until the director's successor has
- 22 qualified following the directors' election held on the uniform
- 23 election date in November 2012.
- 24 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 25 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 26 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 27 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,

- 1 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 2 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 3 Government Code.
- 4 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 5 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 6 Environmental Quality.
- 7 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 8 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 9 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 10 representatives within the required time.
- 11 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 12 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 13 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 14 and accomplished.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
