- 13 grandfather, Marvin Baird, at Baird Tire Company in Kilgore; he
- 14 later became the owner and operator of the business; and
- WHEREAS, At the age of 40, Mr. Perkins decided he wanted to
- 16 serve his community as a firefighter, and in 2003, he graduated from
- 17 the Kilgore College Fire Academy; the following year, he became a
- 18 member of the Kilgore Fire Department and the Kilgore Rescue Unit;

- WHEREAS, Mr. Perkins was an engaged member of his community,
- 21 serving two terms as president of the Rotary Club and becoming a
- 22 Paul Harris Fellow; he was an assistant scoutmaster for Boy Scout
- 23 Troop 252 and one of the mountain men reenactors known as the
- 24 Pineywoods Buckskinners; his passion for music was expressed

- 1 through his performances with the Sabine River Bottom Tune Shiners
- 2 quartet and the Sound Connection men's chorus; and
- 3 WHEREAS, A man of strong faith, Mr. Perkins was a deacon at

- 5 optimistic, often volunteering to help others without any thought
- 6 of recognition or reward, and he will be long remembered by all
