WHEREAS, This compassionate and dedicated public servant committed himself to ensuring affordable housing for the people of Odessa, and he played an instrumental role in gaining tax credits for the Key West Senior Village; he also helped revise the city's personnel policies and procedures manual; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Sanchez was active with the Texas Municipal League, and he was a member of the TML's Association of Hispanic Municipal Officials, becoming the organization's treasurer in 22 2007; he was a member of the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic 23 Church; and
