- BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- SECTION 1. Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is amended by 6
- adding Section 73 to read as follows: 7
- Sec. 73. (a) The Texas Veterans Commission and the 8
- 9 Department of State Health Services shall work with the United
- States Department of Veterans Affairs and any other appropriate 10
- federal agency to propose that the federal government establish a 11
- 12 veterans hospital in the Rio Grande Valley region of the state.
- 13 (b) The state may contribute money, property, and other
- 14 resources to the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a
- veterans hospital described by this section. 15
- 16 SECTION 2. The constitutional amendment proposed by this
- resolution shall be submitted to the voters at an election to be 17
- held November 3, 2009. The ballot shall be printed to permit voting 18
- for or against the proposition: "The constitutional amendment to 19
- 20 require partnering with the United States Department of Veterans
- 21 Affairs and other federal agencies to establish a veterans hospital
- in the Rio Grande Valley region of the state." 22
