## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the right to hunt
- 2 and fish.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by adding Section 33 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 33. (a) Every person has the right to hunt and fish in
- 7 this state in accordance with the laws of this state. Hunting and
- 8 fishing are the preferred methods of managing wildlife species that
- 9 are not classified as threatened species by the state agency
- 10 <u>responsible for maintaining the list of endangered or threatened</u>
- 11 species.
- 12 (b) The legislature may enact a general law to define the
- 13 term "threatened" with respect to indigenous species of fish or
- 14 wildlife.
- 15 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
- 17 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 18 proposition: "The constitutional amendment recognizing the right
- 19 of a person to hunt and fish in this state, recognizing hunting and
- 20 fishing as the preferred methods of managing wildlife species that
- 21 are not classified as threatened species, and authorizing the
- 22 legislature to enact a general law defining "threatened.""
